Due to Cassioppi's involvement and continued mentoring, the client has thrived, was adopted and is now a successful young adult attending college. Since that first case, Cassioppi has continued to represent children and vulnerable adults in difficult circumstances through Children's Law Center and Volunteer Lawyers Network.
