GENERAL ORDER No. 73


Temporary Restrictions on Courthouse Access due to  
Coronavirus Disease Public Health Emergency

It is hereby ordered that effective March 17, 2020, in light of the current COVID-19 (Coronavirus Disease) outbreak, and the concerns listed in this court's General Order No. 72, all courthouses of the United States District Court, Northern District of California, shall be closed to the public until May 1, 2020. Only persons having official court business authorized by General Order No. 72, or by a presiding judge, may enter courthouse property. This order applies to the following divisional locations:

- (1) The United States Courthouse, Floors 15 through 19 of the Phillip Burton Federal Building at 450 Golden Gate Ave., San Francisco;
- (2) The United States Courthouse of the Ronald V. Dellums Federal Building at 1301 Clay Street, Oakland;
- (3) The United States Courthouse of the Robert F. Peckham Federal Building at 280 South First Street, San Jose; and
- (4) The United States Courthouse at 3140 Boeing Avenue, McKinleyville.
